**Abstract:** The article presents the speeches of the participants of a symposium organized by James Campbell and Richard E. Hart and co-sponsored by the American Association of Philosophy Teachers. It relates that the symposium is a byproduct of the 2007 meeting of the Society for the Advancement of American Philosophy (SAAP) and it aims to advance the initiative to make philosophy teaching more effective. The speeches cited include that of Vincent Colapietro of the Pennsylvania State University, Herman de Regt of Tilburg University in the Netherlands and Douglas Anderson of the Southern Illinois University. Moreover, it adds that the speeches focus on the experiences of the professors in introducing the philosophy of Charles Sanders Peirce to undergraduate students.
