Quote: The categories directly point out that anything may be regarded, first, in the aspect of a simple Quale; secondly, as in Relation to other things; and thirdly, as a Sign, that is as referring to an *object* in virtue of determining an interpreting sign, which [I] call its *interpretant*[,] to refer to the object in the same way.
