**Term:** Logical Interpretant

**Quote:** ...there is a third interpretant, to which no object of the sign corresponds. It is what we commonly call the *meaning* of the sign; but I call it the logical interpretant, or logical meaning of the sign. [—] It is not, however, all signs that have logical interpretants...
