Cognitio: Revista de Filosofia is a biannual journal published by the Center for Pragmatism Studies (CPE) of the Philosophy Graduate Program at the Pontifical Catholic University of São Paulo (PUC-SP). The journal is internationally indexed in The Philosopher's Index, Citas Latinoamericanas en Ciencias Sociales y Humanidades (CLASE), International Philosophical Bibliography (Répertoire Bibliographique de la Philosophie—Bibliografish Repertorium van de Wijsbegeerte), Erih Plus (European Reference Index for the Humanities and Social Sciences—ERIH), Ulrich's International Periodicals Directory, and Latindex. Cognitio proposes to publish papers by Brazilian and foreign researchers and, thus, gives room to a fertile dialogue and discussion of ideas between the national and international philosophical community around its central theme.

Cognitio is calling for original and unpublished papers, and book reviews of interest to the scientific community, to be published in its next issues. We accept contributions in Portuguese and English, which will be submitted to a blind peer review. Should there be some doubt at this stage of the evaluation, Cognitio will count upon the contribution of a third reviewer. The delivery of the papers does not ensure publication. Cognitio contemplates the publication of papers that, to some extent, relate to the theoretical universe of Pragmatism, both classic and contemporary, encompassing themes on the theory of knowledge, semiotics, logic, philosophy of language, ethics, aesthetics, and metaphysics.
